

Tripler Army Medical Center Department of Anesthesia and the Tripler Medical Simulation Center (TMSC) are proud to offer a one-day Anesthesiology MOCA Simulation Course, a high fidelity simulation educational experience with a focus on crisis management in the perioperative setting. Board-certified anesthesiologists who complete this course can receive 20 points toward Part IV of their American Board of Anesthesiology (ABA) Maintenance of Certification in Anesthesia (MOCA®) requirement and 5 additional points for completing the post-course survey and 30-day follow-up to document practice improvements. The course is open to military and DOD anesthesiologists, as well as civilian anesthesiologists. Tripler is the first Army Medical Center and the second Department of Defense (DOD) site to be endorsed by the American Society of Anesthesiologists (ASA).
